Name of the Program Conducted: Idea Club competition 2024 -2025

Title: Report on Intra Institutional Innovation Competition Poster and Model

Organized By: DBCOP's IIC & RIC

Date: 12/12/24

Introduction

The Intra Institutional Innovation Poster, Model and Museum Competition was organized to provide a platform for students to present their creative and innovative ideas. The event aimed to promote interdisciplinary learning, foster problem-solving skills, and encourage students to think outside the box. Students from various colleges participated, showcasing their talent through posters and working models.

Event Details

The competition was held on 12/12/24 at Dadasaheb Balpande college of Pharmacy under the guidance of Research and Innovation Cell. The event was organized in two rounds:

- **Round 1:** Screening of all posters and models.
- **Round 2:** Final selection, where the top 5 teams in each category were chosen to compete for the top positions.

The competition saw enthusiastic participation, with students presenting 4 scientific models and 48 posters, where 26 posters were from PG category, 13 posters were from UG category and 3 posters were from PPG category and 5 museums.

The themes for the competition included:

- Medicine and pharmacy.
- Agriculture and animal husbandry.
- Pure science.
- Management and commerce.
- Humanities language and fine arts.
- Engineering and technology



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The competition was inaugurated by Dr. Ujwala Mahajan Principal and Chairperson, IIC, DBCOP, Dr Ritesh Fule Co-ordinator and Secretary, RIC DBCOP, Dr Vidya Sabale Co-ordinator and Mrs. Monali Dumore Co-ordinator RIC DBCOP who emphasized the importance of innovation and creativity in solving real-world problems.

Competition Highlights

The event consisted of three main segments:

1. **Poster Presentation:** Students presented detailed posters depicting their innovative ideas and concepts. Each team explained the scientific, social, or technological significance of their work. Posters explaining cutting-edge topics such as Ibuprofen as a potential therapeutic agent for Alzheimer's disease, Formulation, development and characterization of solid lipid nanoparticles of ribavirin to target peste des petits virus in ruminants.
2. **Model Exhibition:** Participants displayed working models showcasing practical and scalable solutions to contemporary challenges. Innovative projects such as Animal vital parameter detector, Multipurpose dual chamber germicidal system, etc.
3. **Museum Exhibition :** Each class participated as team and exhibited a museum on a theme compiling with the labs in front of which the museum is present. Each class showed team work and creativity at their best.

Judging and Evaluation

The competition was judged by a panel of 12 Evaluator experts from academia.

The evaluation criteria included:

- Content
- Organization and Structure
- Innovative Idea
- Presentation Skill
- Defense

The judges were impressed by the depth of research, innovation, and presentation skills demonstrated by the participants.

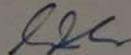

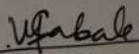

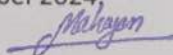
