Abstracts should not exceed more than 250 words.

The abstracts should be structured and contain title (Top of the paper, centered, bold, uppercase, Times New Roman 14, name of authors (last name followed by initials, name of presenting author to be underlined, Times New Roman, 10), complete address of the institution including the state, country and pincode (Times New Roman, 10), Email ID of the presenting author, Key words (not more than 5, Times New Roman, 10), aims, objective, methodology, results and discussions, conclusions, references and acknowledgements.

- Last date of submission of abstracts: 30th October, 2019
- Intimation of acceptance will be sent by 7th November, 2019

It is mandatory for the presenting author to avail CRS-IC membership if not already a member.
